Note:

1979: Bond contested the election as an "Independent Ratepayer" candidate. He was a prominent member of the local Liberal Party, and received unofficial support from local Liberal Party members and from various Ratepayer Association members. The Liberal Party had previously announced that they would not contest the by-election.

Hixon issued a leaflet in which he stated that he aimed to poll 3,500 votes. The leaflet continued: "I am desirous to carry out your wishes whenever possible. This is a golden opportunity for my Labour, Liberal and Tory friends to consolidate their efforts by voting for me."

1982: Bond, Mears and Mrs. Wilkerson were the candidates of the Pinner Ward Ratepayers' Association.

1990: Olins joined the Minority Conservatives in February 1992 following Conservative Group divisions on the level of Community Charge to be set for the 1992-93 municipal year. He rejoined the official Group at the end of March 1992.
