Note:

- 1990: Clark and Mrs. Clark resigned from the Council's Conservative Group in April 1991 with Cllr. Sailor (Greenhill). They told the local press that they had disagreements with the leadership over education financing and policy, but remained "enthusiastic Conservatives" committed to the re-election of a Conservative Government. Both rejoined the Conservative Group in August 1991 upon the dissolution of the Independent Group.
- 1994: Tuck resigned from the Liberal Democrats in November 1997 and became an Independent Councillor, aligning himself with the other Independent (and former Liberal Democrat) Councillor, Cllr. Crossman (Ridgeway). They called their new grouping "The Constituents' Party", but it was dissolved in March 1998 when Cllr. Crossman joined the Conservative Party. As a result, Tuck reverted to being an Independent Councillor.
