

## Appendix Q

### THREE WARDS FOR PINNER PARISH

The Parish of Pinner was relatively large in terms of area. The publication of the 1914 *Register of Electors* revealed that, for the first time, the parish had been divided into three polling districts, no doubt for the convenience of electors. The polling districts were:

- i. Village — based, as the name implied, on the traditional village of Pinner.
- ii. Hatch End — a north-eastern extension of Pinner that started to be developed in the second half of the nineteenth century, close to the LNWR railway line.
- iii. Headstone — the part of the parish closer to the centre of modern Harrow, including the historic Headstone Manor and the Cunningham Park area.

It was not until the 1925 Hendon RDC and Pinner Parish elections that the division was formalised by converting the polling districts into wards. The allocation of Pinner's five RDC seats and nine Parish seats was as follows:
