

## Appendix Y

### POPULATION DATA, 1901-1931

The 'Vision of Britain' web site contains population data for local authority areas for the early twentieth century period. The following statistics have been abstracted from the site and help illustrate the growth of Harrow, Wealdstone, Kingsbury, Pinner and Stanmore between the four census years of 1901, 1911, 1921 and 1931.

Note: Harrow-on-the-Hill UD was enlarged on 1 October 1928 by the addition of 101 acres of land from Uxbridge RD. At the census of 1921 the area concerned had a population of 168.

Hendon RD was reduced in size on 1 April 1931 by the loss of Edgware parish to Hendon UD.
