1954: (24/6) At the meeting of the Council held on 25 June 1954 lots were drawn to determine the person elected to fill the vacancy with the longer term. This was done by the members concerned drawing slips of paper bearing the year of retirement from books held by the Town Clerk. The result was that Mrs. Haslam was determined to fill the vacancy with the term ending in 1957, while Samson was determined to fill the vacancy with the term ending in 1955.

1962: Atkinson resigned from the Council in June 1964. No by-election took place to fill the vacancy.
