THE 1977 REGISTER OF ELECTORS: INTRODUCTION AND POLLING DISTRICT ANALYSIS

Scope

The *Register* contained the names, in street order, of all persons entitled to vote at Parliamentary and Local Government elections. The 1977 *Register* was the last to be compiled using the ward boundaries first introduced for Harrow's 1949 council election. It was strikingly similar to the 1953 *Register* that was discussed and analysed in *Harrow Votes: The Urban District of Harrow 1934-1953*. Polling districts in the majority of wards were still assigned the same letters; additionally, the polling places were often the same.

The 1977 *Register* was issued by R. Hill, Electoral Registration Officer for the London Borough of Harrow, from his department at the Civic Centre, Station Road, Harrow.

Dates

The qualification date to be included in the *Register* was 10 October 1976. It came into force on 16 February 1977 and was valid until 15 February 1978.

Qualifications

The principle requirement for inclusion in the *Register* was a simple one of residency on a certain date. There was also a 'Service' qualification for members of the armed forces and other persons outside the state on diplomatic or other Crown business; there was an additional qualification for Merchant Seamen.

The electorate for Local Elections was essentially the same as that for Parliamentary Elections: by 1977 non-resident qualifications had been abolished. Persons liable for jury service were no longer marked.

Marked Names

- **S** Printed before the name indicated a Service voter.
- Printed before a name indicated a Peer or Peeress (other than an Irish Peer) and <u>not</u> entitled to vote in respect of that entry at a Parliamentary Election.
- M Printed before the name indicated a Merchant Seaman.

An example of a rare 'L' name was Sidney F. Greene, entry CA1705 at 26 Kynaston Wood in the *Register* for Harrow Weald ward. Greene, who had been General Secretary of the National Union of Railwaymen (NUR) from 1957 to 1975, was created Baron Greene of Harrow Weald in 1974.

Dated Names

The Representation of the People Act 1969 extended the franchise to 18 to 20 year olds. A number printed immediately before an elector's name indicated the eighteenth birthday of the voter, meaning that they had reached voting age on that day, and would be able to vote at elections held on or after that day. Therefore a marking of 6/7 meant that the elector would be able to vote at elections held on or after 6 July 1977 whilst one of 15/1 meant that the elector would be able to vote at elections held on or after 15 January 1978.

The number of dated names found in the *Register* for a typical ward — Stanmore South — is shown below:
