PROGRESS OF THE POLL, 1964 AND 1968

Subsequent to the first election to the new London Boroughs in 1964, the London County Council published details of the progress of the poll for each of the boroughs. In 1968 the same role was fulfilled by the Intelligence Unit of the Greater London Council. The practice was discontinued at the 1971 election.

The table below reproduces the published data for Harrow at the 1964 and 1968 elections, showing the percentage voting in the borough for each hour that the polling stations were open. An extra column provides the cumulative percentage voting.
