**ANALYSIS OF VOTES BY PARLIAMENTARY CONSTITUENCY**

This Table analyses the votes (using “Averaged Data” votes, as explained in the introduction to Table 5) in Parliamentary Constituencies. Due to the presence of unopposed returns, a column of the Table indicates how many wards were contested. The greater the number of contested elections, so the reliability of the analysis in showing the political “mood” in a constituency increases. T’out is for the contested wards.

The analysis for 1946-1948 is based on the Parliamentary Constituencies used at the 1945 General Election, whilst the analysis for 1949-1953 is based on the Parliamentary Constituencies used at the 1950 and 1951 General Elections. In 1946, 1947 and 1948 a uniform pattern of voting is assumed within Harrow Weald ward with the figures being split 86%:14% (Harrow East : Harrow West).
