Any candidates with double surnames (hyphenated and unhyphenated) have been cross-indexed to ease reference.

During the period of these elections, the person nominated had to be properly described on the nomination paper for the purpose of identification. All the names of the candidate had to be stated in full, their true place of abode given and their description added, viz. their rank, profession, or occupation. Where this description is known it has been included in the index.
