## INDEX TO CANDIDATES — HENDON RDC ELECTIONS

The number or numbers following the name of each candidate indicates the election or elections when the candidate stood. The numbers are in the abbreviated form of the year: e.g. 94 = 1894; 01 = 1901; 22 = 1922, etc. An asterisk (\*) following the year indicates a by-election or co-option. Any candidates with double surnames (hyphenated and unhyphenated) have been cross-indexed to ease reference.

The letter abbreviations within brackets indicate the parish or parish ward that the candidate contested, as follows: P = Pinner, HW = Harrow Weald, GS = Great Stanmore, LS = Little Stanmore, E = Edgware, V = Pinner (Village), HE = Pinner (Hatch End), H = Pinner (Headstone).

During the period of these elections, the person nominated had to be properly described on the nomination paper for the purpose of identification. All the names of the candidate had to be stated in full, their true place of abode given and their description added, viz. their rank, profession, or occupation. Where this description is known it has been included in the index.
