THE MAY 2022 REGISTER OF ELECTORS: INTRODUCTION AND LIST OF POLLING DISTRICTS

Scope

The *Register of Electors* contains the names, in street order, of all persons entitled to vote at Parliamentary and Local Government elections. (Anonymous registration is available to people meeting certain statutory requirements where, if their name or address were listed on the *Register of Electors*, their safety would be at risk.)

Harrow's May 2022 *Register*, to be used at the Borough Election of 5 May 2022, was issued by Hugh Peart, the Electoral Registration Officer for the London Borough of Harrow, from his department at the Civic Centre, Station Road, Harrow.

Dates

Since 2001, as a result of the Political Parties, Elections and Referendums Act 2000, the annual 'revised' *Register of Electors* is published on 1 December, although it is possible to update the *Register* with new names each month between January and September. Additionally, the Returning Officer is able to issue a "Notice of Change" as late as 9 pm on the day of election in order to correct a clerical error in the *Register*. Such alterations can be made by virtue of Section 13B(3B) or 3(D) of the Representation of the People Act 1983 (as amended). The last date for applications for inclusion in the *Register* in time for the 5 May election was 14 April 2022.

Qualifications

The right to register for voting extends to all British, Republic of Ireland, qualifying Commonwealth and European Union citizens. British citizens living overseas may register for up to 15 years after they were last registered at an address in the UK. (Overseas electors are only qualified to vote in Parliamentary Elections.) It is possible for someone to register before their 18th birthday as long as they will reach that age before the next revision of the *Register*.

Marked Names

- F** Printed before a name indicates an Overseas elector only registered to vote at Parliamentary Elections.
- G** Printed before a name indicates a European Union Citizen elector only registered to vote at Local Government Elections.
- L** Printed before a name indicates an elector, usually a Peer or Peeress, not entitled to vote in respect of that entry at a Parliamentary Election.

Dated Names

A number printed immediately before an elector's name indicates the eighteenth birthday of the voter, meaning that he or she had reached voting age on that day, and would be able to vote at elections held on or after that day. For example, a marking of 6/7 meant that the elector would be able to vote at elections held on or after 6 July 2022 (and so would not be able to vote on 5 May) whilst one of 15/2 meant that the elector would be able to vote at elections held on or after 15 February 2022.

At this election, the figure has been taken from the Notice of Poll for each ward published on 26 April 2022: each Notice contained details of the Situation of Polling Stations and the *Register* entries entitled to vote at each Station.

The total number of electors entitled to vote at the election for each polling district are in fact slightly different to the base number due to the presence of:

(a) Insertions made under the revising, 'rolling register', arrangements. Such entries receive a polling number such as 974/1, 974/2, 1471/1 etc. at their point of insertion.

(b) 'Deleted' entries.

(c) 'Dated' entries for persons not yet 18 years old on 5 May 2022.
