**HARROW WARD STATISTICS: 2022 ELECTORAL EQUALITY**

Following the ward boundary reorganisation, not all wards elected the same number of Councillors. Eleven wards elected two Councillors and the remaining eleven wards elected three Councillors.

This Table explores the electoral equality of the new system. A ward that is ‘under-represented’ displays a +ve variance from the average number of electors per Councillor, while an ‘over-represented’ ward has a -ve variance. Three wards in particular — Greenhill, Marlborough and Wealdstone South — displayed large negative variance. The Local Government Boundary Commission, in its May 2019 final recommendations, stated that it was expected that projected residential developments in central Harrow would bring the number of electors per councillor more into agreement with the Borough average.
