Note:

2022: Crossman and Yogalingam acted as their own Election Agents, an indication that they contested the election separately.

2026: Kamala Kannan contested the election using a shortened form of his surname (Kannan).

Prior to 2026, Sockalingam had been an election candidate three times:

- i) In 2014 as a list candidate at the European Parliament election, London constituency,
- ii) At the General Election in 2015 for the Ruislip, Northwood and Pinner constituency, and
- iii) In 2022 for Rayners Lane ward (see above).

On these three occasions his first name was Sockalingam and last name Yogalingam. For the 2026 election the order of his names was reversed on all official paperwork, as shown above. A note at the end of Section One of the Index to Candidates, page 62, provides a short explanation of Tamil naming customs, one of which can lead to a change in the order of names.
