After the close of nominations, Smith's membership of the Conservative Party was suspended when it was disclosed in April 2026 that he had made a number of social media posts that were described, by a Labour Party spokesperson, as "deeply concerning". Smith's suspension was reported by news outlets in May 2026, shortly before polling day. Due to electoral law, the suspension had no effect on his position as a nominated candidate and his ballot paper description remained 'Conservative Party Candidate'. Votes cast for Smith have been included in aggregate statistics for the Conservative Party. See Appendix K for further details.
