HARROW WARD STATISTICS: 2024 PREDICTIONS

This Table explores the electoral equality of Harrow's wards in 2026 compared to expectations for 2024. As before, a ward that is 'under-represented' displays a +ve variance from the average number of electors per Councillor, while an 'over-represented' ward has a -ve variance. The 2024 predicted electorates were presented in the final recommendations published by the Local Government Boundary Commission for England in May 2019.
