POPULATION DATA, 1901-1931

The 'Vision of Britain' web site contains population data of local authority areas for the nineteenth and early twentieth century periods.

The following data has been abstracted from the site and helps illustrate the growth of Harrow, Wealdstone, Pinner and Stanmore between the four census years of 1901, 1911, 1921 and 1931.
