Note:

1934-1939: There were two RA groups in the ward: the Pinner Association and the Hatch End Association.

1934: The Pinner Association endorsed four candidates for the three vacancies: Cope, Weston and Mrs. Potts were members of the Pinner Association, Dawson was a member of the Hatch End Association.

Ellement and Pither issued a joint election address.

Mrs. Barnett called for an adequate representation of women on the Council.

1952: Peever issued a joint election address with the Independent Labour Party candidate for Pinner South ward, Henry S. Birkett.
