VOTES CAST AT DISTRICT ELECTIONS, 1934-1939

These figures are presented in two ways. First, as “Raw Data”, where all votes are summed, irrespective of the number of Councillors to be elected per ward and the number of candidates nominated per Party. Second, and where appropriate, as “Averaged Data”, where only the average vote per Party per ward is used. Although the latter method avoids distortions caused by parties not necessarily nominating a complete “slate” of candidates in each ward, it cannot compensate for “missing” votes in a contested ward where a Party nominates no candidates, or where there is an unopposed return.
