Note:

- 1986: Burrows and Hains were among 35 signatories of a statement which appeared in *The Guardian* in March 1989. In it they reaffirmed their "belief in, and commitment to the values of Liberalism set out in the Preamble to The Liberal Party constitution" and committed themselves "to continue to promote The Liberal Party as the only organisation dedicated to campaign consistently for Liberalism at every opportunity". They remained members of the Council's Liberal Democrat Group until the 1990 election.
- 1990: Sailor resigned from the Council's Conservative Group in April 1991 and formed an Independent Conservative Group with Cllr. Clark and Cllr. Mrs. Clark (Pinner West). He rejoined the Conservative Group in August 1991 upon the dissolution of the Independent Group.
- 1998: Krushner changed his surname by deed poll in July 1998 to Kerr.
