Note:

- 1978: A third Conservative Party candidate, Abdul K. Jiwani, was nominated, but withdrew shortly before the close of nominations. Jiwani told the press that he had decided not to stand for personal reasons. It was subsequently discovered that Jiwani was technically an alien and that his nomination should have been declared invalid by the Returning Officer.
- 1981: Cohen resigned from the Council in September 1981 after Kenton East Labour Party had selected Davies as their third candidate for the 1982 election.
- 1986: An Independent Ratepayer candidate, Narandra Shah, was nominated to contest the election, but he subsequently withdrew his nomination papers. He called on his supporters to vote for the Labour candidates.
- Mrs. Davies resigned from the Council's Labour Group in June 1987. She remained a member of the Labour Party.
