Note:

1934-1948: The main RA group in the ward was the Pinner South Ratepayers' Association.

1934: The newly-elected councillors reached an agreement amongst themselves that Cowan would serve for a term of three years, Swann for a term of two years and Champion for a term of one year. The arrangement meant that the drawing of lots, as provided for in clause 18(4) of the Middlesex Review Order 1934, was unnecessary.

1935: At the Annual Meeting of the Council held on 16 April, lots were drawn under the direction of the Chairman to determine the person elected to fill the casual vacancy. The result was that Champion was determined to fill the casual vacancy (with a term of one year) and Grant-Carter determined to have been elected to fill the vacancy arising from the ordinary election (with a term of three years).

1936: Grant-Carter resigned from the Council at the same time as and in sympathy with Cllr. Frank Clark (Headstone ward).

1952: Birkett issued a joint election address with the Common Wealth Movement candidate for Pinner North and Hatch End ward, George R. Peever.
