Note:

- 2002: Lent resigned from the Council's Labour Group in July 2004 following his acceptance of paid employment with the Rowntree Trust. Lent remained a member of the Labour Party and supported Labour Group Budget and Council Tax proposals until he retired from the Council in May 2006.
- 2010: In May 2013 Mrs. Asante-Twumasi became a founder member of the 'Independent Labour Group' on the Council, an action that resulted in her expulsion from the Labour Party. See Appendix K for further details.
- 2014: In late July 2017 Mrs. Amadi was suspended from the Labour Party so as to allow an investigation to take place into allegations that she had made a number of homophobic statements on the internet. Early in August 2017 she resigned from the Labour Party.
