**Note:**

- 2006: Mrs. Kinnear was expelled from the Conservative Group in February 2009 for “a series of serious breaches” of Group rules.
- 2010: Borgese, Mrs. Kinnear and Mrs. Jones told the local press that they were “separate candidates” who were united with the aim of “representing residents without political party influence.”
- Gawn appeared at Hendon Magistrates’ Court in January 2012 to deny a charge of the attempted theft of £7,000 from a Dennis O’Brien on 5 August 2011. On 15 March Magistrates dismissed the case under Section 6 of the Magistrates’ Courts Act 1980: namely, that there was insufficient evidence for a trial by jury because no *prima facie* case had been established. The Crown Prosecution Service re-charged Gawn and re-registered the case on 27 March. This led to a new appearance at Hendon Magistrates’ Court on 14 May and committal to Harrow Crown Court where he pleaded not guilty on 22 June.
- At a further hearing at Harrow Crown Court on 19 November Gawn pleaded guilty to one count of fraud and one count of attempted theft having tried to cash two cheques totalling £10,000 written from O’Brien’s cheque book without his permission. Gawn was sentenced on 20 December 2012 to concurrent ten-week jail sentences, suspended for one year, and a six week doorstep curfew. Further information on the case can be found in editions of the *Harrow Observer* and *Harrow Times*.
- Any sentence of imprisonment, including a suspended sentence, of over three months would have resulted in Gawn’s disqualification. Gawn was suspended from the Council’s Labour Group during this period. Following his conviction, Gawn became the subject of an investigation by the London Labour Party, but he resigned his membership of the Labour Party in January 2013 before the investigation was completed.
- 2013: (7/11) Idaikkadar’s description on the ballot paper was ‘Harrow First’. He was, however, the candidate of the Independent Labour Group and has been shown as such.
