Note:

- 2002: Ingram resigned from the Labour Party (and therefore also from the Council's Labour Group) in March 2003. He was opposed to the involvement of British armed forces in military operations in Iraq. Ingram supported Labour Group Budget and Council Tax proposals until he retired from the Council in May 2006. In April 2006 he joined the Green Party.
- 2010: In May 2013 Dharmarajah became a founder member of the 'Independent Labour Group' on the Council, an action that resulted in his expulsion from the Labour Party. See Appendix K for further details.
