Note:

- 2006: Miss O'Neill contested the 1994 election in Hatch End ward under her married surname of Finch. Reverting to her maiden name after her divorce in 1997, Miss O'Neill subsequently became Mrs. Noyce upon her marriage in March 2010. She contested Rayners Lane ward at the 2010 election.
- 2010: At the time of the election Bond was ticket officer manager at North Harrow Underground station. He had been a prominent campaigner against the closure of ticket offices on the London Underground system.
- 2014: Bond and Mrs. Weston sought election on a joint 'ticket' with Bond acting as election agent for both of them.
